

Overall, TCF is stronger, more visible, more effective and better equipped to meet the challenges of 2016 and beyond, thanks to your generous support.



2015 was our biggest year to date:

- Our staff grew to three full time members.
- We addressed over 23,000 people around the country.
- We launched poignant and praised new programs that were embraced by the media, teachers, employers, students and celebrities alike.
- The organization more than doubled its revenue over 2014, with grant revenue alone increasing 400%, and our annual Upstander Legacy Celebration raising almost \$130,000.
- News of our work reached 107 million individuals in the summer months alone, and our story continued to change hearts across the globe.

"Bullying is the leading cause of Youth aggression in America. Bullying presents one of the greatest health risks to children, youth, and young adults in U.S. society. It is pernicious in its impact even if often less visible and less readily identifiable than other public health concerns. Its effects on victims, perpetrators, and even bystanders are both immediate and long term and can affect the development and functioning of individuals across generations."

#Day1's launch helped establish us as a national player in the anti-bullying space, with stories of its highly anticipated launch reaching 107 million people in the summer months alone. Endorsements soon followed from the National Education Association, the American Federation of Teachers, UN Free and Equal, and Rutgers, whose chancellor read the @Day1 script to 5,000 students at its August 30th convocation.

The Tyler Clementi Institute for CyberSafety

The Tyler Clementi Institute for CyberSafety at New York Law School launched in October to a packed room and a dozen media stories celebrating this first-of-its-kind free clinic dedicated to representing victims of cyberharassment for free. A partnership between TCF and the NYLS, this unique response to the epidemic of cyberbullying and revenge porn will do more than protect victims; it will change the law as we know it to protect future harassment from happening in the first place.




