As a Youth Ambassador, you are valued and appreciated for your commitment and volunteer efforts to the organization. By accepting the title of **Youth Ambassador**, you understand that your behavior directly reflects upon the Tyler Clementi Foundation's reputation. Modeling Upstander behavior by being kind, compassionate and inclusive of others and ourselves are all behaviors and values that are expected and encouraged.

For this reason, the Tyler Clementi Foundation has listed the following expectations:

1. **Uphold Upstander behavior online and offline.** Do not engage in bullying, harassment, or humiliation online or offline. Stand up for others when they are bullied if you feel safe to do so. Reach out to trusted adults to help intervene or the Tyler Clementi Foundation staff for program-related questions.
2. **Act maturely when representing the Tyler Clementi Foundation.** Behave with etiquette. Honor the Golden Rule of treating others as you would like to be treated. Be responsive to communications with stakeholders or potential stakeholders.
3. **Honor Tyler's story.** Do not speak on the Tyler Clementi Foundation's behalf unless agreed upon by the Tyler Clementi Foundation staff. Keep your language regarding the Tyler Clementi Foundation consistent with official messaging and language.
